

In the wake of the declaration of COVID-19 as a pandemic, the Government announced the closure of all academic institutions in the country until May 31, 2020. Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) has constituted a nine-member committee, comprising vice-chancellors of prominent varsities, to work in tandem with higher education institutions. The committee has started working for the promotion of online teaching and smart classrooms to students within the province.

The first meeting of the committee held on March 31, 2020, via Zoom, was chaired by Prof. Dr. Fazal Ahmed Khalid, Chairman PHEC, Prof Dr. Niaz Ahmad Akhtar, Vice-Chancellor, University of the Punjab, Lahore, Prof Dr. Talat Naseer Pasha. Vice-Chancellor, University of Education, Lahore, Dr. Naeem Tarig, Rector, Virtual University of Pakistan, Prof. Dr. Syed Mansoor Sarwar, Vice-Chancellor, University of Engineering & Technology, Lahore, Prof Dr. Muhammad Ashraf Vice-Chancellor, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad, Prof Dr. Khalid Masud Gondal, Vice-Chancellor, King Edward Medical University, Lahore, Prof Dr. Rukhsana David, Principal, Kinnaird College for Women, Lahore attended the meeting.

The committee proposed the following recommendations to improve the online access to higher education and mitigate the impacts of lockdown due to COVID-19:



Universities should start online and blended teaching-learning processes using different software such as Google Meet, Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Google Hangouts, etc.

Universities should provide training to faculty members involved in blended learning and ensure student engagement.

Students who are unable to attend online sessions should have an opportunity to access course material online.

As the universities are autonomous they can revise their academic calendar as required and formulate policies to ensure quality, maintenance of minimum requirements for online education and revision of assessment and grading policy for assignments/quizzes, midterm and final exams.

In case of practicals, labwork and projects the faculty members are advised to provide online guidance and advice to the students.

Institutions having good Learning Management Systems (LMS) should assist other academic institutions.

PHEC will work with HEC and HED to update on policy matters and check with universities to evaluate their needs of IT infrastructure, automation, assessment and LMS.

PHEC organizes Stakeholders Conference On Higher Education Reforms

Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) organized a "Stakeholders Conference for Higher Education Reforms" on Wednesday, January 22, 2020, at the University of Engineering and Technology (UET), Lahore. Minister for Higher Education and Information Technology, Mr. Raja Yassir Humayun Sarfraz (Chief Guest), Chairman PHEC, Prof. Dr. Fazal Ahmad Khalid. Vice-Chancellors from 22 public sector universities, DPI Colleges (Punjab), Mr. Jehangir Ahmed, and Principals from approximately 700+ public sector colleges of Punjab participated in the interactive conference.









Separate discussions with Vice-Chancellors of public sector universities and principals were also arranged, where the Minister for Higher Education Punjab and Chairman PHEC outlined plans with regard to the implementation of Associate Degrees, restructuring of the colleges' affiliation mechanism through the introduction of Divisional Universities for equitable distribution, and effective management of affiliated colleges in each division.



College Education is an important pillar of the higher education sector, however, this sector has long been ignored in the province. PHEC has taken initiative to uplift the college sector by introducing various quality reforms. The capacity building of college faculty is an important variable to achieve this goal. PHEC Staff Development Academy is equipping college faculty with the best teaching skills by organizing the training workshops. From January to March 2020, Staff Development Academy has organized 11 training workshops and imparted skills to a total of 468 faculty members including Lectures and Assistant Professors from public sector colleges from all nine divisions of Punjab.

Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) organized a one-day Workshop on "Role of Start-ups in Research Commercialization" on 21 January 2020 at PHEC. Federal Minister for Education and Professional Training Mr. Shafqat Mehmood, Provincial Minister for Higher Education & IT Raja Yassir Humayun Sarfraz and Chairman PHEC Prof. Dr. Fazal Ahmad Khalid graced the event.

Consultative Meeting
with Editors of Local Journalists

Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) organized a meeting with the editors of local research journals on March 12, 2020. The meeting was attended by more than 70 editors under the convenorship of Chairman PHEC Prof. Dr. Fazal Ahmad Khalid. Prof. Dr. Syed Muhammad Awais, Executive Director, Institute of Orthopedics and Rehabilitation Sciences, Lahore, and Dr. Muhammad Ramzan Director-General (AR&A) PHEC also attended the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to deliberate with the editors and elicit their feedback on improving the quality of research manuscripts, capacity building of authors and issues related to the publishing of journals at par with international standards.





Expansion of Community

Colleges Project under Phase-II

An interactive session with the principals of 54 public sector colleges, identified by DPI for inclusion in the expansion of Community Colleges project, was held on Feb. 2, 2020, at PHEC Head Office, under the convenorship of the Chairman PHEC, Dr. Fazal Ahmad Khalid. The participants were briefed that in the first phase, 9 colleges from 9 nine districts were approved under PC-I "Establishment of Community Colleges in Punjab" through which Associate Degrees on the semester system pattern, in market-driven subjects, were being offered to produce employable graduates.

It was further briefed that a PC-I entitled "Expansion of Community Colleges (Phase-II)" of Rs. 128.719 has been approved by the Government of Punjab through which 27 colleges from the remaining 27 districts are to be identified. Under this PC-I, lab equipment will be provided to the selected colleges and local training will be given to the faculty. Moreover, these 27 colleges will also be included in the approved PC-I "Establishment of IT Labs and Smart Classrooms" of Rs. (196.879) through which smart classrooms will be established. Through both these PC-1s, each of the 27 colleges will receive an average funding of Rs. 9.63 million.

At the end of the session, a committee was constituted to identify 27 suitable colleges for the expansion of the program. The committee held its meeting on March 5, 2020, under the convenorship of Ch. Jehangir Ahmed, DPI (Colleges), Punjab. During the meeting, the assessment forms submitted by the Principals of 54 colleges to DPI were reviewed according to the pre-defined criteria for enrollment, infrastructure and available faculty. After detailed deliberations, 27 colleges were identified by the committee for further processing.



PHEC Signs MoU with Qasim Ali Shah Foundation

Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) and Qasim Ali Shah Foundation (QASF) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on January 27, 2020, at PHEC Head Office, Lahore. On February 15, 2020, Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Lahore Chamber of Commerce and Industry (LCCI) to collectively work for strengthening higher education, research, and industry-academia linkages. The areas of mutual interest include the promotion of Applied Research and Commercialization. Chairman PHEC Prof. Dr. Fazal Ahmad Khalid and President LCCI Mr. Irfan Igbal Sheikh signed the collaboration document.

Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) aims to strengthen the culture of research in higher education institutions (HEIs) of the province through the provision of funds and expertise to conduct national and international conferences, seminars and symposia. Funding for conferences is an ongoing program. A committee of experts reviews each proposal submitted and decides about requests for funding on merit. In the first guarter of 2020, two meetings of the "Expert Review Committee" were held where a total of 31 cases were approved with a total of funds amounting to Rs. 14,367,709/-

Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) awarded a total of 22 international travel grants (ITGs) to the scholars (public sector universities = 16, private sector universities = 5, and public sector colleges = 1) during the first guarter of 2020. The ITGs were awarded in the 32nd meeting of the International Travel Grants committee held on January 17, 2020. Prof. Dr. Fazal Ahmad Khalid, Chairman PHEC, presided over the meeting. The committee reviewed a total of 41 cases for the grant. International Travel Grants is a special initiative of Punjab Higher Education Commission, under which, faculty members, non-teaching staff and Ph.D. students are

provided funding for presenting their research findings and

PHEC Launches International Research Support

Fellowship Program (IRSF)



In order to provide scholars with international exposure during their research work, Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC) has launched an International Research Support Fellowship (IRSF) Program. The program is of six-month duration, and specifically designed to provide first-hand experience in research to the highly motivated scholars who are currently pursuing a full-time Ph.D. degree in HEC recognized universities in Punjab.

The IRSF shall provide the doctoral students with bench fees, living cost/stipend, and return airfare, provided that the candidates have secured acceptance from research supervisors in the top 200 QS ranked universities. PHEC has launched the program through advertisement in national dailies in response to which students and faculty members from all over Punjab have forwarded their applications with research proposals. Shortlisted candidates have been interviewed for further processing.
